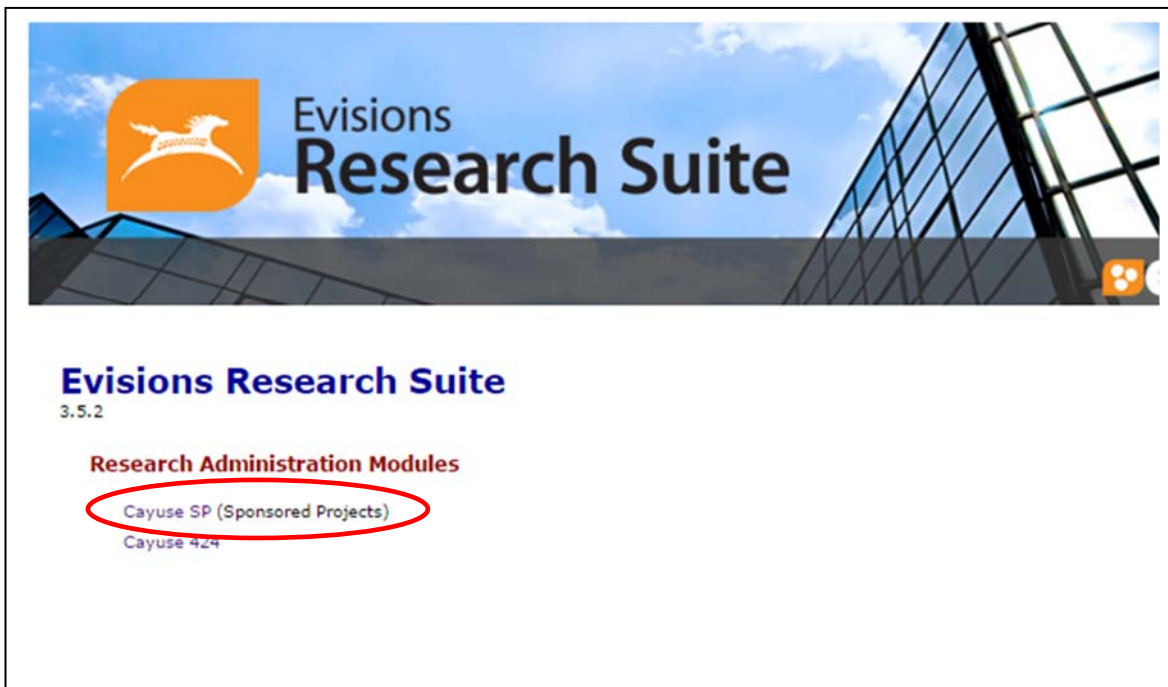
## PI CERTIFICATION INSTRUCTIONS

All members listed on the Research Team of a proposal package must certify the proposal information on the electronic IPF (proposal) Form in Evisions SP.

To complete the PI Certification process you will need to log in to Evisions ([wayne.cayuse424.com](http://wayne.cayuse424.com)) using your ACCESS ID & password.

Evisions can be accessed from any location that has internet access. All browsers are supported.

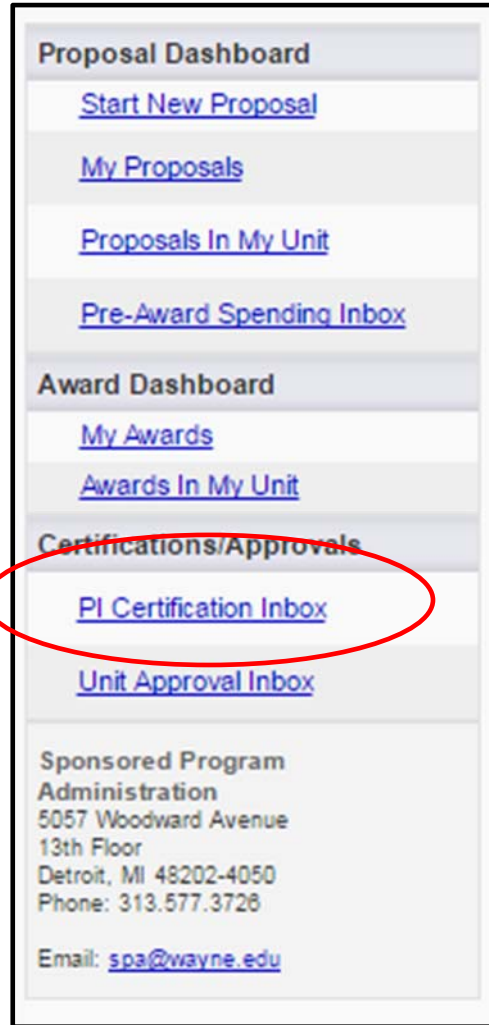
After logging into Evisions, you'll see the following screen:

Select the PI Certification Inbox and click the tab that reads To Be Certified, locate the appropriate electronic IPF and click on the proposal number.






