To improve the quality of our service to the research community and facilitate protocol approval in a timely manner, we are making some changes to the protocol submission and review process.

Starting with the November meeting (Oct. 23rd deadline), CITI training modules for Principal Investigators and laboratory staff, including the 3-year refresher, must be completed **prior to** protocol submission. Submissions containing untrained personnel will be returned without review.

Please note that this applies only to the online CITI modules and not to the hands-on Division of Laboratory Animal Resources (DLAR) training. DLAR training is still required for final approval but will be arranged *after* a protocol is submitted.
