

# Does your lab ship hazardous materials or any materials on dry ice?



- Hazardous materials must be shipped by an Office of Environmental Health & Safety (OEHS) staff member or other trained personnel.

**Under DOT Dangerous Goods regulations, penalties for violations are severe.**

- **DRY ICE is a Class 9 – Miscellaneous Dangerous Good:**

ALL materials on dry ice are regulated and must be shipped as dangerous goods.

- **LITHIUM BATTERIES are Class 9 – Miscellaneous Dangerous Goods:**

These batteries are regulated and require special packaging and labeling.

- Some chemical and biological compounds are non-regulated and may be shipped without Dangerous Goods training.
